



Surveyed to Daniel Elgin on the 12th November 1825 the above described tract of two hundred and thirty five acres and nine tenths of an acre and allowance of six percent - as represented by the dark lines being part of two surveys - that marked A.D. is part of a larger survey made to Thomas Patterson and Henry Patton on the 11th March 1786 containing three hundred and forty three acres and one quarter of an acre and allowance - By warrant of the 9th Day of January 1786 - and that marked C.D. was surveyed on a warrant to Andrew McClenahan on the 8th December 1785 - containing one hundred and twenty eight acres and seven tenths of an acre and allowance - joining Thomas McClenahan John King and others in Center Township Indiana County as appears from papers in my office
