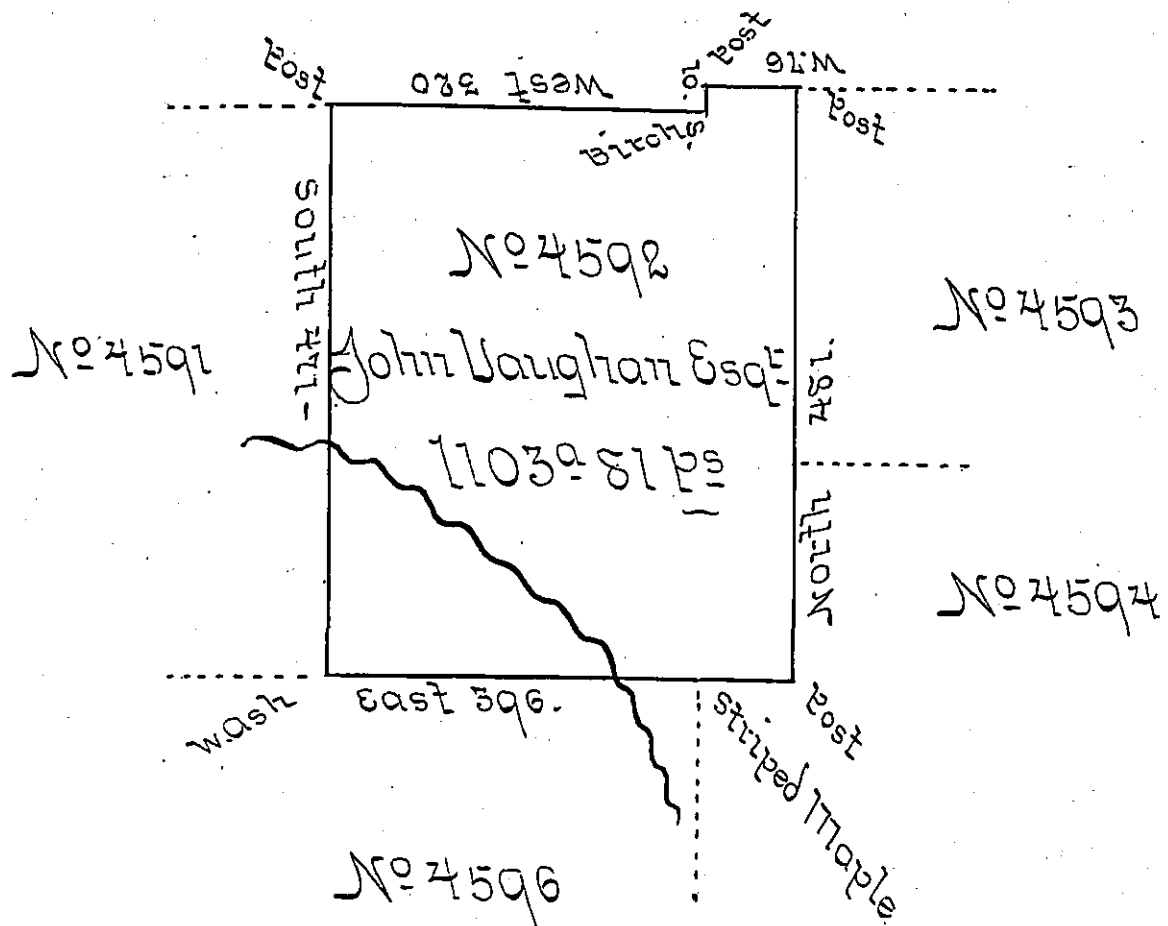


Henry Drinker Esq<sup>r</sup>
