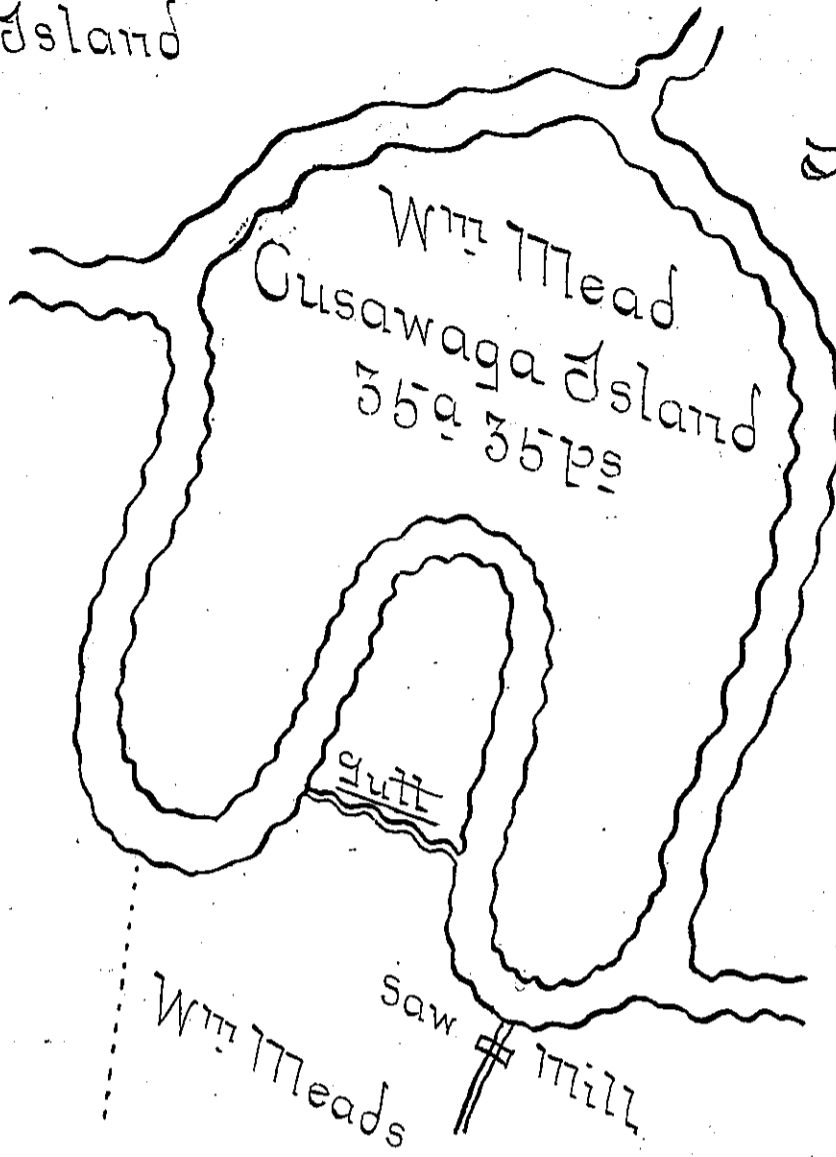


River Course from a maple on the
