I am thy real fr^d

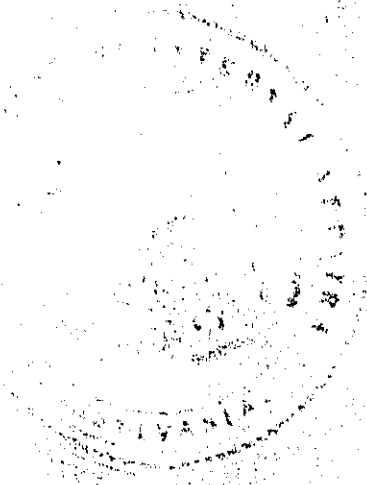
