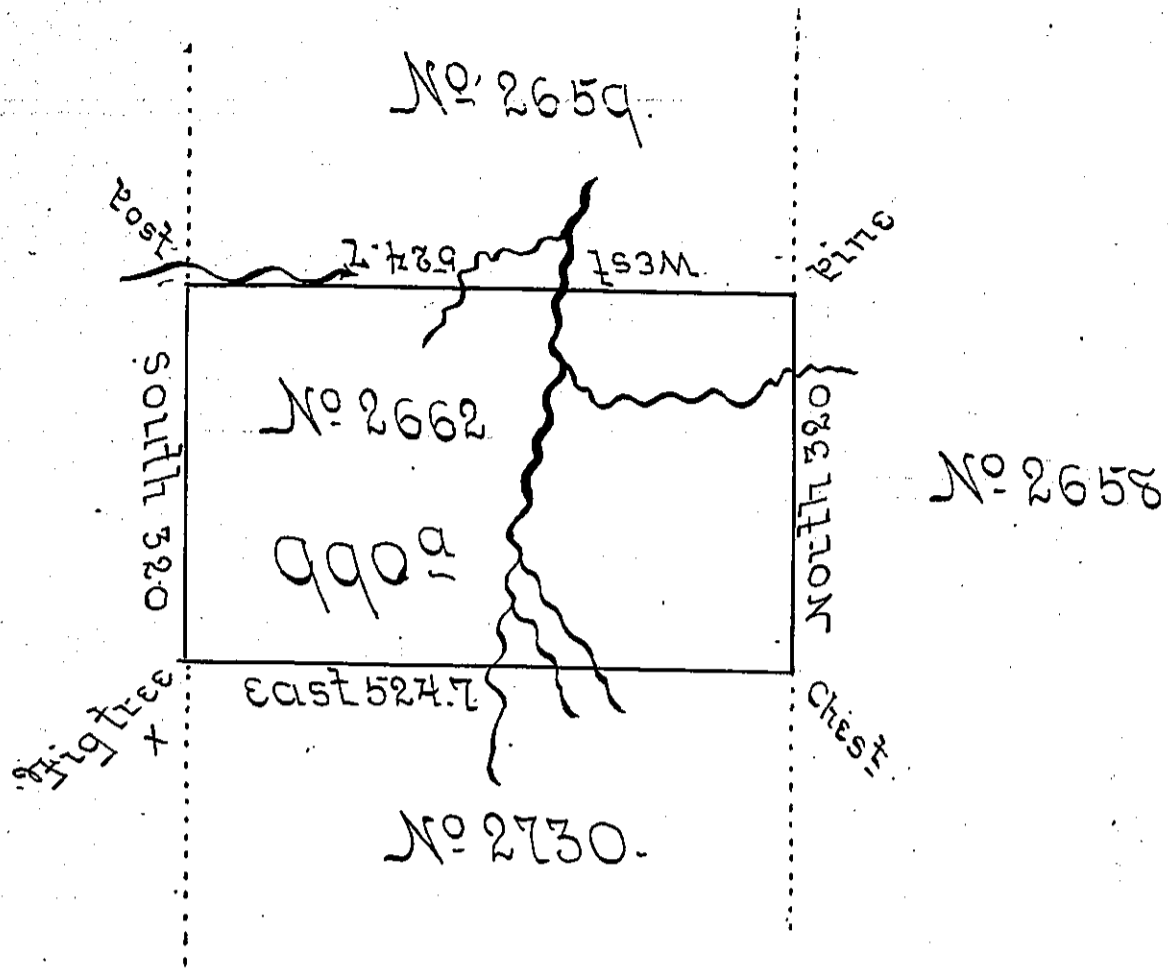


John Brodhead's District
