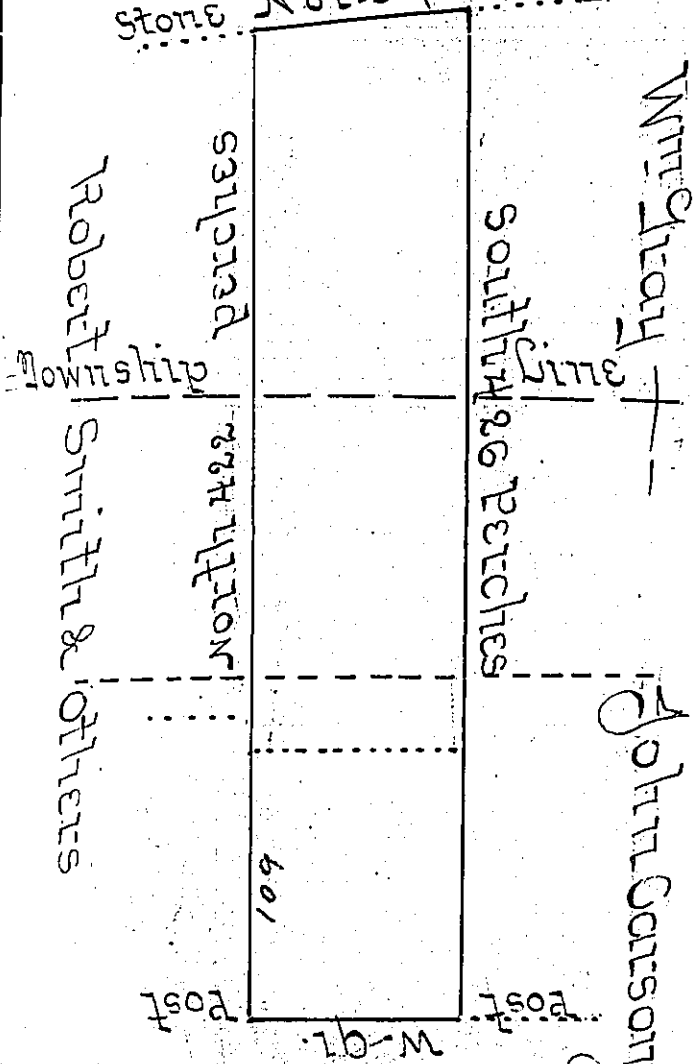

U.S. It appears from the survey book that the above tract of land was surveyed to William Findley on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of April 1805 and it does not appear that the land is otherwise appropriated except about sixty two acres of the south end which is represented by a dotted line said sixty two acres are claimed by the Holland Land Company - Findley has been in possession of the premises since his first survey thirty two years -
