



A Draught of a tract of land in Waterford Township Erie County on the Waters of French creek Surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> of November 1802 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 15<sup>th</sup> of November 1801 granted to Joseph Clarke containing 403 Acres 112 perches Allowance &c.
