



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Fair View Situate on the Westerly side of the North East branch of Susquehanna River above and adjoining land surveyed for Edward Dumlap about Six or Seven Miles above the Mouth of Fishing Creek in the County of Northumberland containing three hundred and four Acres & eight Perches besides the usual allowance of 6 Percent for Roads &c. Surveyed for The Reverend Doctor Francis Allison the 4th day of June 1773 in Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 5th day of January 1773
