A Draught of a Tract of Land Surveyed the 10th day of August 1795 for Doctor James Armstrong in pursuance of his warrant for 286 acres dated the 12th day of February 1794 Situate northwest of the River Ohio Allegheny and Conawango Creek on the River Ohio opposite to the upper end of Montour Island through which the McIntosh path passes including the mouth of a Large run which enters into said River being No. 137 in Samuel Nicholsons old district of Depreciation Land containing two hundred and eighty six acres together with the usual allowance of Six percent.
