



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated ^{fourth} ~~fourth~~ day of May 1734 Surveyed unto Henry Bittou a tract of land situate near the head of Saccoon creek adjoining to Adam Warners land Beginning at a post in ye line of Adam Warners land thence by Vacant land South one hundred and Eighty perches to a post thence by Vacant land west one hundred and forty two perches to a Black Oak Sapling thence by Vacant land North one hundred and eighty perches to a alder sapling thence by Vacant land east twenty perches to ye sd. Warners corner being an ash thence by ye sd. Warner ye same course one hundred and Twenty two perches to ye place of Beginning containing one hundred & fifty acres with ye usual allowance of Six pcent. Surveyed June 8th 1734
