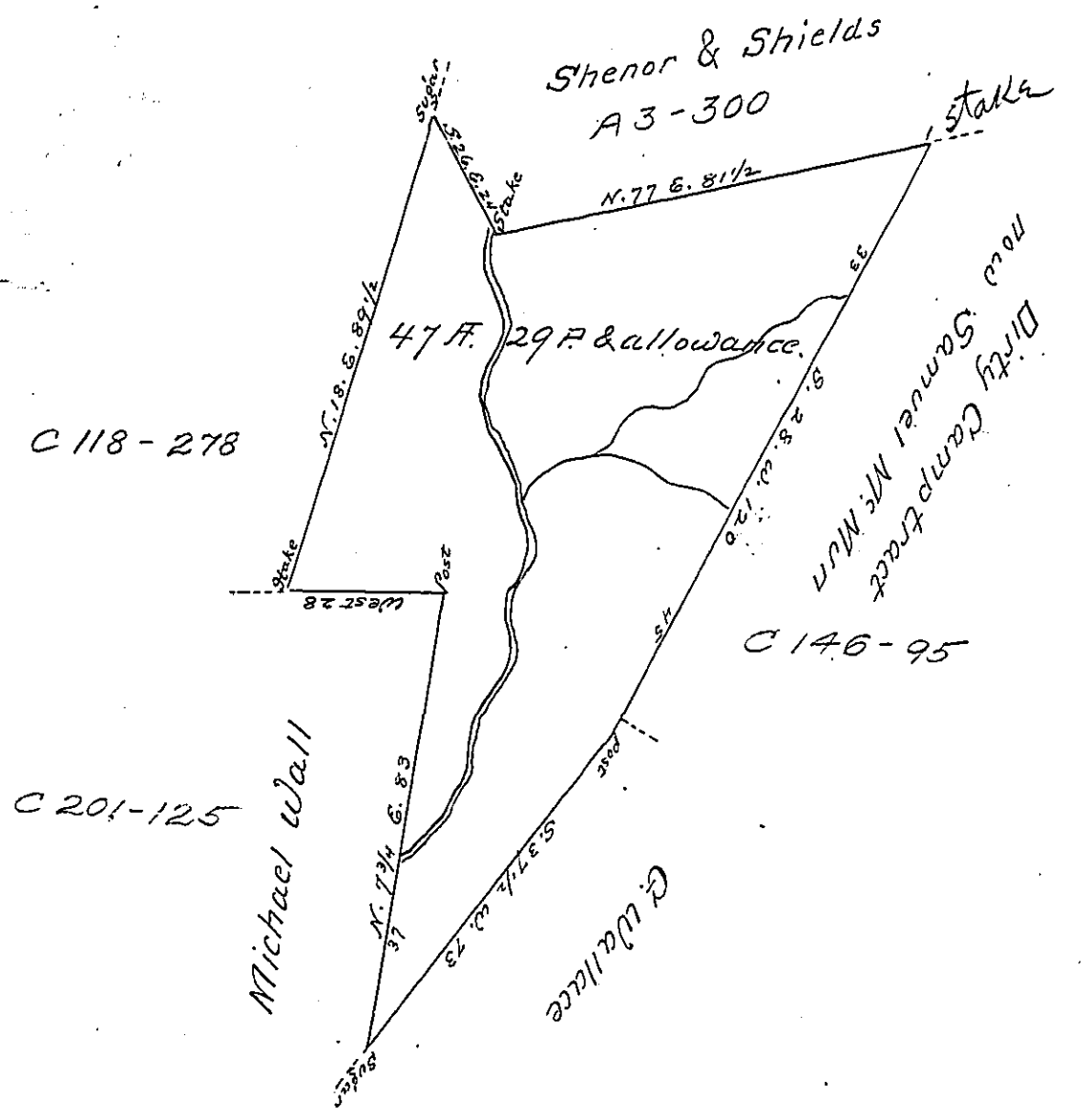

 perches & allowance B. Highlands D.S.

I have examined the above Survey and find it correct. —
 Note - there is no date to Mr. Highlands survey, on the survey book
 but from Documents in my possession it appears to have been
 executed Dec. 19th 1825 and recorded in 1829, — the balance of
 the land called for in the Warrant was lost at law before the
 survey and is owned by Samuel ^{Mc} Mun who has lately sent
 for a warrant for the same.
