



A Draught of a Survey called "Paxton" situate on the waters of Buffalo Ck. in Washington County, contg. 400 acs. strict measure, executed June 20th. 1786 in consequence of a Certifc. for 400 acs. granted to Edward Anderson by the Commrs. appointed by Virginia to adjust the claims to unpatented lands in the Counties Monong<sup>a</sup>. Yohg<sup>a</sup>. and Ohio, and duly entered with the County Surveyor as appears from the List of Entries transmitted from the Surveyor Generals office.
