



In pursuance of an Order N^o 3727 Dated the 9th of August 1769 Survey'd for James Cooper the above Described tract of Land (called the Gallant) containing two Hundred & fifty two Acres, and 153 perches with an Allowance proportioned to 6 p cent Situate Between Loyalhanna & Conemaugh on a small run heading into Conemaugh abt 7 or 8 miles North of the Chesnut Ridge in Westmoreland County &c Survey'd the 15th August 1770
