By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 13th February 1750 and in Obedience to an Order of the Board of Property dated the 5th day of October 1789 Resurveyed the 7th January 1790 to Frederick Altimus the above described tract of land (in the Presence of Anthony Kleckner & Andreas Fetzer agreeable to the lines & division formerly made between said Kleckner and Andreas Graft long before Fetzer purchased & he then acknowledged he had purchased no farther than the division line) Situate in Moore Township Northampton County Containing in the whole tract Eighty Acres One hundred and thirty six perches and the allowance of six p. cont. &c
