By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Twenty ~~third~~<sup>fifth</sup> day of March ~~1733~~<sup>1734</sup> Surveyed unto William Roberts a Tract of Land situate in Oley in the County of Philada. Beginning at a post a corner of Benjamin Boones land thence by the same South Twenty degree west one hundred & forty perches to a post thence by land laid out for William Morgan North Seventy degree west fifty one perches to a post in the line of John Alpricks land thence by the same North twenty degree east twenty perches to a white oak a corner of sd. Alpricks land thence by the same North sixty four degrees west one hundred & eighty five perches to a Hicky sapling thence by land of Peter Milton North twenty degrees east ninety six perches to a post thence by land of Godwick Klapp South seventy degrees east twenty one perches and the same course by land of Benjamin Boone Two hundred and fourteen perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred ~~sixty three~~<sup>fifty nine</sup> ~~& fifty eight~~ acres with the usual allowance of Six p Cent.
