



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the eighteenth day of May 1734 Surveyed unto Conrade Riell a tract of Land situate near Oley in the County of Philad^a. Beginning at a post thence by his other land North Sixty five degrees east two hundred perches to a Chesnut oak thence by Vacant Land South twenty five east Eighty five perches to a post thence by Vacant Land south sixty five degrees west two hundred perches to a Chesnut tree thence by Vacant land North twenty five degrees west eighty five perches to ye place of Beginning containing one hundred acres with the usual allowance of Six pcent.
