



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated
the eleventh day of June 1734 Surveyed unto Michael Miller
a tract of Land situate in Mapetaway in the County of
Philada Beginning at a post in the line of John Holders
land thence by the same South eighty degrees west ninety three
perches and by Vacant Land the same course seventy seven
perches to a Hickory thence by Vacant Land North Ten degrees
West two hundred perches to a post thence by Vacant Land North
Eighty degrees east one hundred and seventy perches to a Black Oak
thence by Vacant land South eleven degrees East two hundred
perches to ye place of Beginning Containing two hundred acres
with the usual allowance of Six per cent.
