



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the fourth — day of May 1734 — Surveyed unto ^{John} Phillip Bauman a Tract of Land situate on Saccoon Creek in Bucks County Beginning at a Swamp oak thence by Vacant Land west two hundred and twelve perches to a post thence by Vacant Land North one hundred & Sixty perches to a post thence by Vacant Land East two hundred & twelve perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South one hundred and Sixty perches to ye place of Beginning containing two hundred acres of Land with ye usual allowance of Six pcent.

Surveyed June 7th. 1734.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventh day of January 1902
