



By Virtue of a warrant from ye Proprietaries dated the 26th day of February 1733 Surveyed to George Rutter a certain tract of Land Situate in Oley in the County of Philad^a Beginning at a white oak thence North west by Land of Martin Alstedt Seventy Seven perches to a post thence by Vacant Land north east two hundred and twenty two perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South east seventy seven perches to a corner stone thence South west by the sd. George Rutter's other Land two hundred and twenty two perches to ye place of Beginning containing one hundred acres with the usual allowance of Six pcent.
