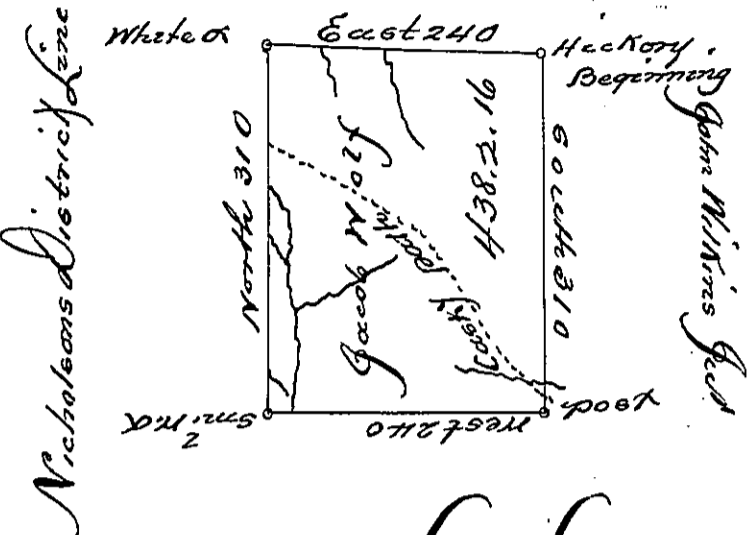

A Draught of a Tract of Land Surveyed April the 11th 1794 for Jacob Wolf
in Pursuance of his warrant for 400 acres of Land, Dated the Twenty Third
day of July 1792. Lying north north and west of the Rivers of Ohio &
Allegheny and Conawango Creek. Called the Chesnut Level about
three quarters of a mile from No. 13 south Eastward on the Cincus Key
old Road and adjoining Land granted to Hugh H. Brackerridge on the
waters of Pine Creek and Louries Run. Called Chesnut Level
Containing four hundred thirty eight acres and ninety six perches to-
gether with the usual allowance of six ft. Centum for Roads.
