



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 14th day of June 1785 was Survey'd for Jacob Neagley the above described Tract of Land containing Two Hundred & Seventy eight acres and one Hundred and nine perches with an allowance proportioned to six p Cent Situate on the South side of Allegheny River adjoining Land of John McKee and others in Pitt Township Westmoreland County Survey'd September 12th 1785
