



Situate on south side & on the Yougiogheny River in Dunbar Township & County of Fayette, Surveyed the 23rd of December 1839. In pursuance of a warrant in the ^{name} of John Husband dated the 26th day of February 1788 calling for one hundred acres. The above survey according to my calculation contains One hundred and sixteen acres & fifty two perches ^{& allow} has on it a Sawmill & three dwellinghouses and one family residing at present, appears to have been improved 4 or 5 years.
