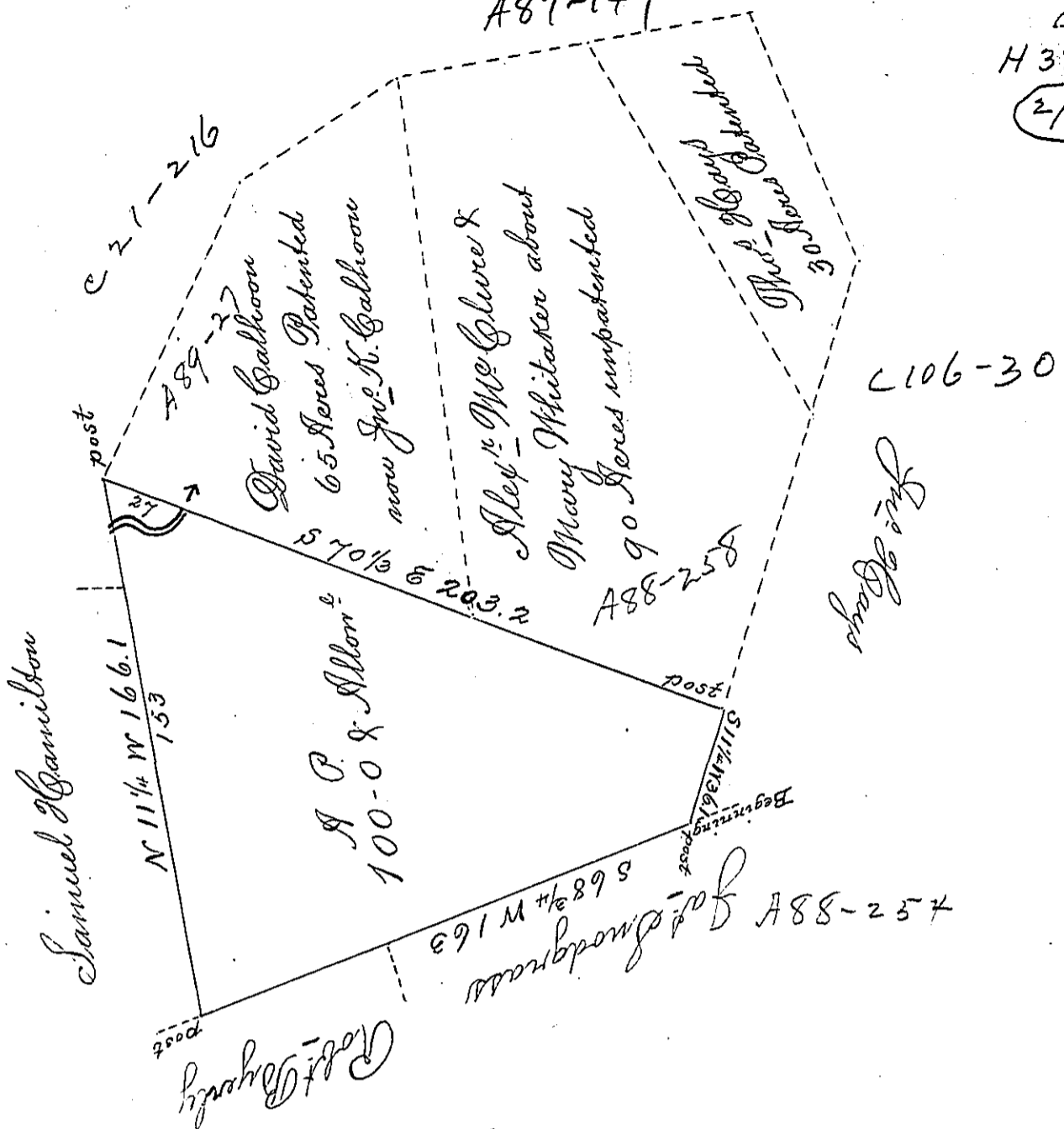

The above is a Draught of a Survey made June 8th 1837 for James Ferguson, Containing one hundred Acres & Allowance of six per Cent. Situate in Mifflin Township, Allegheny County. It is part of an Original ^{survey} executed May 5th 1784 by David Redick Es. D.S. in pursuance of an Order No. 3571. in the name of Andrew Bousman Containing 284 Acres & 144 perches & Allowance, Called McGlures Retreat. Ferguson owns & occupies the part now Surveyed for him, and the balance represented by the Dotted lines, is occupied as above specified.
