



A Plan of a Lot of Ground situate on the North side of High Street in the Town of York marked on the General Plan of the said Town numbered one hundred & three, containing in Breadth on the said street sixty five feet and in length to a twenty feet alley two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Southward with High Street aforesaid westward with a Lot of Ground marked on the said plan Number one hundred and four Northward with a twenty feet Alley and Eastward with a Lot of Ground marked on the plan aforesaid Number one hundred and two, formerly surveyed and laid out for Charles Barnett who has built an house thereon according to the conditions of settling the said Town.
