



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Whitehall Township in the County of Northampton and Province Pennsylvania, containing thirty three acres and 89 perches of land together with the usual allowance at six feet bent for Roads. That was surveyed unto Christopher Beard in pursuance of a Warrant from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries of this Province Dated at Philadelphia on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January Anno. 1759. Surveyed on the 22<sup>d</sup> April Anno. 1755

Noted. A Draught for the same Tract was formerly returned into the Surveyor Generals Office. But as said, not to be found. The warrant was taken out after the survey Anno. 1758.
