 Five Miles South of the State Line in the last purchase District No. 4. Surveyed  
 June the twenty ninth 1793 in pursuance of a warrant to William Bingham Es-  
 quire No. 2279. Dated the twelfth day of December 1792 for 1000 acres  
 Containing Eleven hundred acres and the usual allowance of six per cent for  
 Roads &c.
