



Situate on the Middle Branch of the Schuylkill and Creek nine Miles south of the State Line in the East purchase. District No. 4 surveyed June the twenty eighth 1797 in pursuance of a Warrant to William Bingham Esquire No. 2278 Dated the twelfth day of December 1792 for 1000 acres containing Eleven hundred acres and the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
