



Draught of a tract of Land situated in the
 Late purchase part in Pine Creek & part in Brown
 Township Wycoming County on a road leading
 from Jersey Shore to Cowdensport on Allegany river
 and about seven miles from Jersey shore including a
 large spring called the sand spring being the first
 spring on the above mentioned road after beginning
 the rise of Allegany Mountain - Survey'd on the
 sixth day of May 1816 for Daniel Jameson by virtue of
 his warrant No. 794 bearing date 6th September 1786 -
 containing thirty nine acres & one hundred & fifty
 perch - & allowance of six percent for Roads &c.
