



Situate in Franklin & Alleghany Townships Huntington County containing five hundred & twenty one acres sixty perches and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c being part of two tracts of land surveyed in pursuance of two orders of survey granted to Shimeas & Charles Smith, the former dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May 1767. No. 3617 & the latter dated the first of August, 1766 No. 21 & surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> day of Nov. 1766. the two tracts was then said to contain five hundred & ninety nine acres &c, the dotted lines representing the original survey of Charles & Shimeas Smith. This part resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tracts the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1837.
