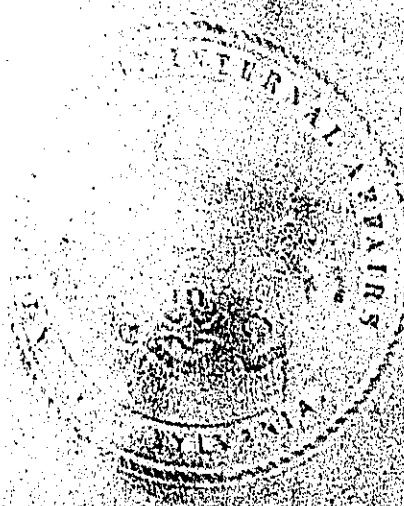


The above is a Draught of a Survey Made February 19th day 1812 Containing 69 Acres of Land with the allowance of six per Cent &c Resurveyed by virtue of an Order from the Board of Property Bearing Date the 10 of December 1811 Situate on Big Whiteley Creek Green Township being the same tract which was surveyed on Warrant Dated the 17 of June 1786 as granted William Minor Sen^r Who obtained a Patented Called Minories Bearing ^{Date} the 5 day of March 1789

The line joining South from the Stone to the Sugar is the old line and from the Sugar to the White oak & hickory is the old surveyed line the old survey takes in the Ironwood Corner about Seven Perches
