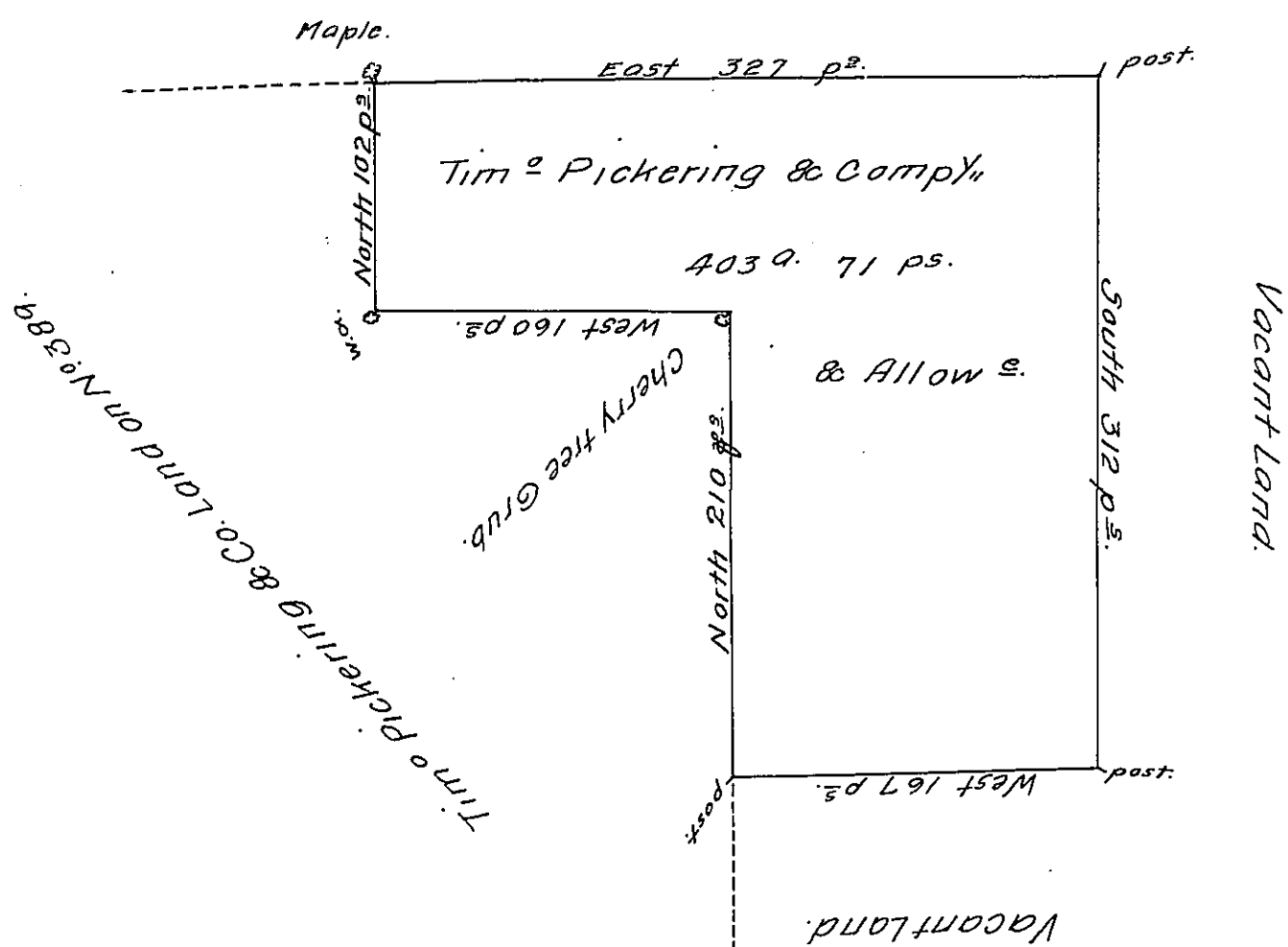


Vacant Land.
