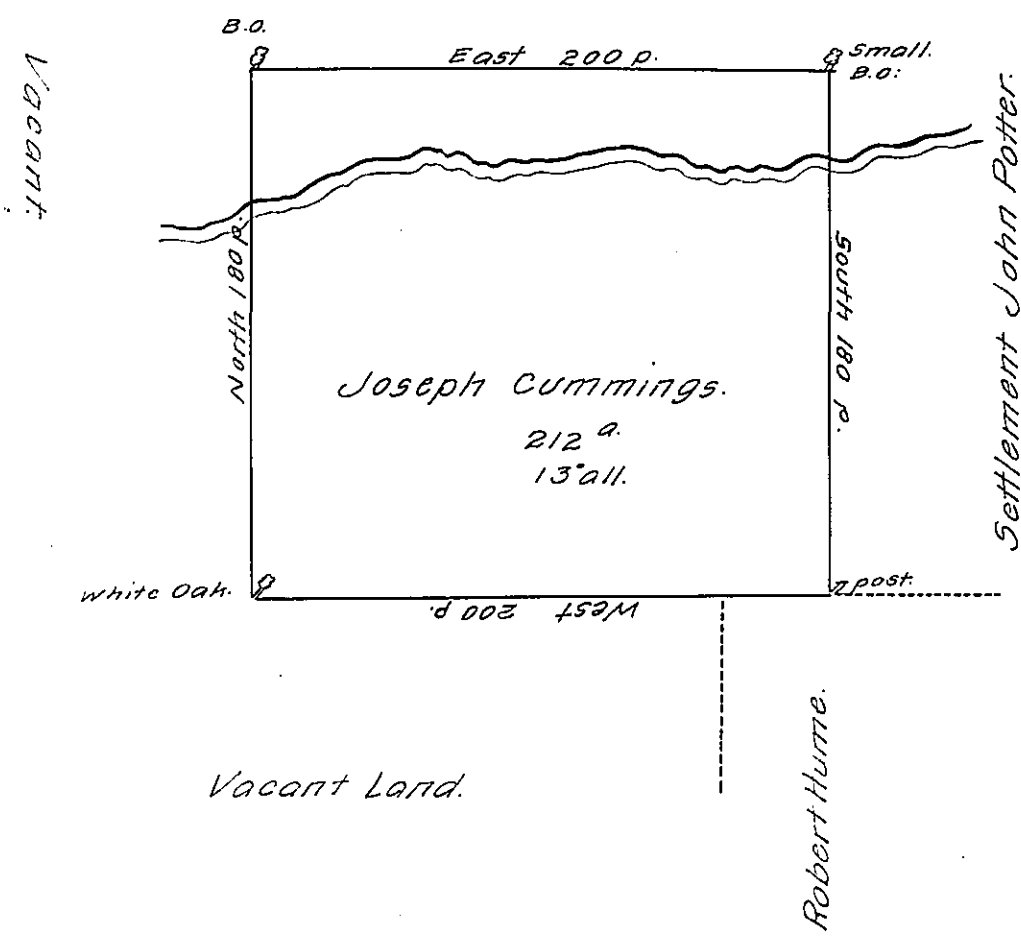


Blue Mountain.



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor, Dated the Seventh day of May Anno Dom: 1737. The above Described Tract of Land was survey- ed Unto Joseph Cummings in the Township of Hanover in the County of Lancaster. Beginning at a small Black Oak Thence South by the Settlem^t of John Potter 180 perches to a post Thence west by ye Survey of Robert Hume and Vacant Land 200 perches to a White Oak thence North by Vacant Land 180 perches to a black Oak Thence East by Vacant Land by ye Blue Mountain 200 perches to the place of Beginning, Containing Two hundred and twelve acres beside the Allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent. for Roads

of Sam. Lightfoot. —

25th of 9^{mo}, 1737.
