



Situate on the waters of Licking Creek in Belfast Township, Bedford County containing one hundred & Twenty two acres & 44 perches & and an allowance of 6 pr. Cent. Surveyd the 14th. day of December, 1792. In pursuance of a warrant dated Nov. the 17th. 1792 for 100 acres. Resurveyd the (6th)th of March 1825 and the Interference with Phillip Gilleland excluded agreeably to an Order of the Bord of Property dated Nov. 2d, 1819 (the rest of the survey being agreeable to the lines found on the ground)
