



A Draught of a Tract of land Called *Saltenstall* situate on a Run that emptyes into the North East Branch of *Susq<sup>a</sup>* River about Eight Miles above *Catawassey* on the southerly side of the said Branch and about a mile & a half from said River adjoining land surveyed for Philip Baker & others on said Run in the County of Northumberland containing three hundred and Eleven Acres and a half Acre besides the usual allowance of 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  c<sup>t</sup> for Roads &c. Surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> Day of September, 1773 for Conrad Graff. In pursuance of a warrant Dated the 25<sup>th</sup>, Day of February, 1773.
