



By virtue of a warrant from the Hon^{ble}. Proprietaries bearing date the Tenth Day of October, Ann. Dom. 1738.

I have surveyed and Laid out unto Matthias Ulric on a branch of Little Conewaga—in the County of Lancaster on the West side Susquehanna river, one hundred and Eighty two acres and forty Eight Acres of Land with allowance of Six Cent in right of Peter Ensminger, Beginning at a Post, thence north sixty nine Degrees Easter one hundred & thirty five perches to two Black Oaks, thence South Twenty one Degrees Easterly, forty two perches to a Hickrey a Corn^r of Leonard Barnitz. Thence north Sixty nine Degrees Easterly Eighty perches to a white Oak Thence North twenty one Degrees westerly one hundred and forty four perches to a Bla. oak. Thence North seventy Degrees Westerly Eighty perches to a Post thence South Sixty nine Degrees Westerly One hundred and two perches to a post Thence South two Degrees Easterly One hundred and sixty four perches to the place of Beginning
