



In the first Survey was de-
 emed to be 251 a. & allowance
 but 33 a. & 135 p. being cut off upon
 a Calculation now there seems to be
 but 212 a. & allowance remaining of which
 this is the Draught.

The above is a
 Draught of a tract of Land
 originally Survey'd the 25th of the
 5th mo. 1759 for George Churchman, In pursuance of a warrant Bearing Date
 23rd of September, 1758, But of late alter'd on account of a warrant &
 claim of James Walker which by consent of Parties, & by directions of the Board
 of Property Dated the 28th of June 1774 was left to the Judgment of two
 men & the above survey made accordingly -- Certify'd ye 21st of 12th mo, 1774
