



Situated at a place called Allum Hill on the Old Road Branch of the Raystown Branch of Juniata about two Miles and three Quarters from the Shawnese Gabbins in the Township and County of Bedford Containing Two hundred and ninety nine Acres $\frac{3}{4}$ with the usual allowance of Six p^r Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed October 22^d 1765. by Richard Tea Dep^y Surveyor and resurveyed March 21st 1793 on Warrant granted to James Dalton Dated July 20th 1765.
