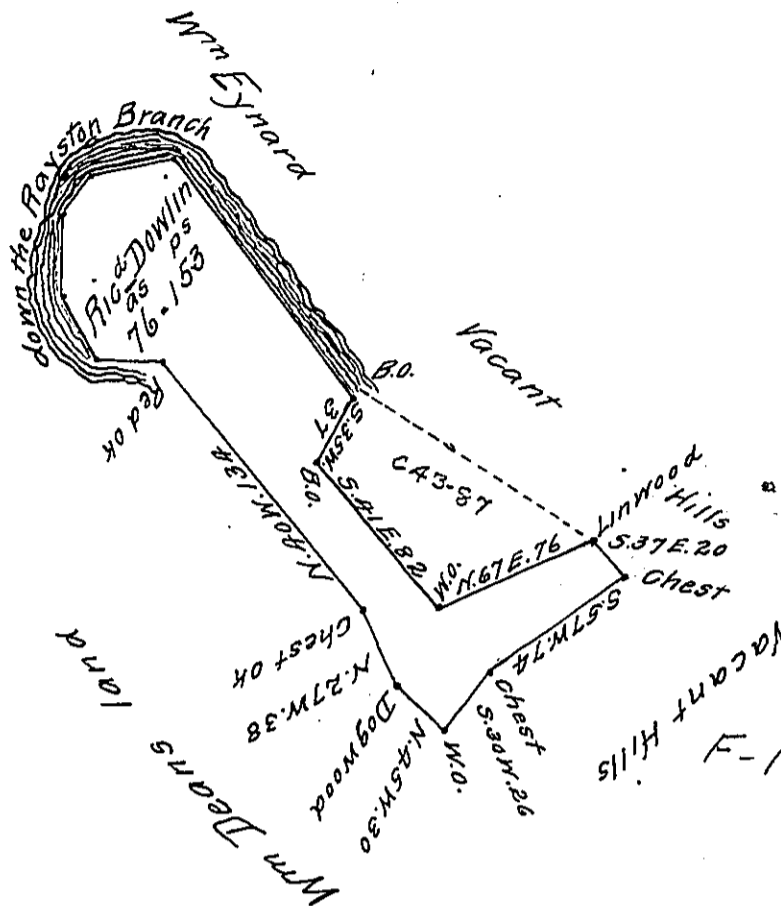

of a Warrant <sup>for 50<sup>as</sup></sup> dated the 22<sup>d</sup> Day of March 1785.
