



A Draft of a Tract of land Situate on the Head waters of Whoopaning Creek, about twelve miles from Wyalusing formerly in Northumberland, Suppos'd to be now in the County of Luzerne, Survey'd on the 26th day of September 1775, by Charles Lukens (the then Deputy Surveyor of the District) for Joseph Fox by virtue of his application bearing date the 17th day of September 1774, which appears by his field works remaining in my Hands, and hath been Carefully examined and found correct by me &c. Containing three Hundred & Seventy seven Acres & one half, with the usual Allowance &c.
