



The above is a Draught of a Survey made June the fifth day 1793. in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to George Leightberger for 100 acres of Land Dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 1792. Situate on the West side of the Allegheny River on the North side of the West branch of Captain O. Marras Saw Mill Run Dejoining the Second Lot in Douglass District in Allegheny County. Called Strawberry Ridge Containing One hundred acres together with the usual allowance of Six p<sup>ct</sup>. Cent. for Roads and Highways.
