



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in the County of Lancaster containing one Hundred and Sixty one Acres and an half and the Allowance of Six Acres p. Cent for Roads & Highways Surveyed the _____ day of _____ by Thomas Cookson Esquire late Deputy Surveyor of Lancaster County for Jacob Nease in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date at Philadelphia the 15th October 1740.

Extracted from a rough draught found amongst Mr. Cookson's Papers in his own hand writing and calculated.

N. Jacob Nease says this Land is situate in Heidelberg Township & was surveyed about 18 or 19 Years ago by Mr. Cookson: neither the Township nor the Date of the Survey are on the rough Draught in my Hands, nor any Notis in the Field Books
