


In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 A Survey was made on the 06th day of July 1772 for William Gray on a certain Lot of Ground situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland mapped in a General Plan of said Town Number Ninety. Containing in Breadth North and South on Broad Way fifty seven feet Six Inches, and in Length East & West Two Hundred and thirty feet. Bounded westward by Broad Way, Southward by Lot Number Ninety One. Eastward by River Alley, and Northward by Lot Number Eighty Nine. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 21st day of August 1776. for Henry Crawford.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this sixth day of April 1917
