



In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a commission under the hand and seal of Office of John Lukens Esqr. Surveyor General for the state of Pennsylvania to me Directed bearing Date at Philadelphia the 14th day of August 1783. The above tract of Land containing two Hundred thirteen acres and thirty three perches and allowance of Six per cent for roads &c. was surveyed on the 25th day of June 1785 by
