In pursuance of a warrant dated the 25th day of February 1785 and Caveated by Obed Garwood who has since obtained a patent to his satisfaction & Charles Gause in consequence thereof has relinquished his claim & requested that I would make return accordingly which I have done and there now no impediment in the way of Patenting this Survey.
