



A Draught of a Tract of Land called — Situate about Twelve Miles from the North East Branch of Susquehanna River on a Branch of LAHAWANACK and on both sides of the Road leading from Well's ferry to Wioming in the County of Northumberland. Containing two hundred and ninety Acres and three Quarters of an Acre besides the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c.

Surveyed the 18th Day of November 1774. for William Gough in pursuance of a warrant dated the 15th day of June. 1774. by Chas. Stewart Dy. suvr.
