



A Draught of a Tract of Land Called — Situate on the Waters of Fall Creek about twelve Miles by Estimation West of Butlers Ferry at Wioming and adjoining the New Road leading from Wioming to the west Branch at a place called the White Spring in the County of Northumberland Containing three hundred and one Acres and three Quarters of an Acre besides the usual allowance of Six p. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 17th day of May 1775 for Andrew Hodge In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 20th day of February 1775.
