



Situate in Fawn Township, York County Surveyed in the year 1764 for Isaac Anderson In pursuance of a Warrant for 50<sup>a</sup>. Dated the 21<sup>st</sup> of June, 176<sup>3</sup> and after that time Robert Stevenson bought me a Warrant in the Name of John Stuart for 50<sup>a</sup>. dated the (obliterated) February, 1763 for the same place and as there was no improvement on the Land 1, at the request of Robert Stevenson run round it again on the 19<sup>th</sup>. Day of the 12<sup>th</sup>. Month, 1771 and left out such part of it as the Province, <sup>line</sup> had cut off and added in Two Small Vacancies.
