



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Sugar Tree Bottom situate on both sides of the Chest Creek about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a Mile above where the Old Trading Path crosses the said Creek adjoining Lands of William Hodge Alexander Stuart Isaac Vannorst and Jonathan Parke in the County of Bedford containing three hundred and seventy Acres and the usual Allowance of Six Percent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> Day of November 1773 for Samuel Bond of the Valley in pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 23<sup>d</sup> Day of July in the same year, by
