



Situate in Alleghaney Township Huntingdon County first surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Baynton & Samuel Wharton dated the 28th day July AD. 1766 it then was said to contain three hundred & forty nine & $\frac{3}{4}$ Acres & Now resurveyed the 3rd day of Oct^r. 1822 in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property to me directed Bearing date the 5th day of Sept^r. 1822 & is found to contain three hundred & Seventy-Nine Acres & 96 perches & allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c.
