Resurveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August 1806 (agreeably to the Old lines for the purpose of Correcting an error in the former Return) to Timothy Pickering, Samuel Hodgdon, Duncan Ingraham Jun<sup>r</sup> & Tench Coxe on their Warrant No 45 dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1785 the above described Tract of Land. Situate in Toby Township Armstrong County on the Waters of Toby's Creek. Containing One thousand and fourteen Acres and One hundred perches and the Allowance of Six # Cent &c.
